- People utilizing multiple opportunities for spiritual growth both corporately and individually.
- People who wholeheartedly pursue discipleship, spiritual formation, and increasing Christlikeness first in ourselves and then also in each other.
- People who proclaim through our worship and baptism our allegiance to God alone and our commitment to serve him only.
- Our worship gatherings will be beautifully engaging for the churched, unchurched, and the next generation.
- Our worship gatherings will help shape us more deeply into Christ's character and point us outside the walls to God's mission.
- Our worship gatherings will embrace both meaningful tradition and creative innovation.

## Radically Pursuing Community

By 2030, we hope to see evidence of these commitments in the following indicators:

- Our communal life will be central and focused. The table of Jesus will be a powerful symbol of the inclusion and relationship we experience in one another.
- A sense of belonging will characterize our interactions with one another.
- The beautiful diversity of our city and world will be more closely mirrored in our leadership, our worship gatherings, and our ministries.
- People of all ethnicities, genders, and ages will be empowered to fully participate in our corporate worship gatherings and the multiple ways we live out that worship in our daily lives.
- All Christians will be free to fully utilize their God given talents in His kingdom.
- Guests are inundated with welcome, hospitality, and an invitation to engage more deeply in our church community.

- We will pursue greater vulnerability with one another. We will feel safe and purposefully engage with each other in difficult but meaningful conversations. Sounds of prayer, confession, and spiritual conversation will become the norm.
- We will cultivate family health: not only the nurturing of healthy individuals and families (marriage, parenting, stewardship, etc.), but also placing an emphasis on family from a kingdom perspective. The love, nurturing, and spiritual growth of children, youth, and emerging adults will be a primary focus. Practical life training is evident.
- We will actively pursue unity in Christ alone on the common ground of God's grace, understanding that unity in the midst of diversity is a sign of spiritual maturity. We will seek to accept any differences among us that do not negate the power of God and his grace. We will seek to embody the following principle: "In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things, love."
- Our life together will be a refuge for all seeking safety, healing, and acceptance.
- Unleash the power of technology to enhance Christian fellowship.
- Regular offering of fellowship and hospitality in large and small groups.
- Intentionally expanding and deepening the relationships each person has in our congregation.
